
Westland Police Department Adds 20 Next Generation Hybrid Cars to Patrol Fleet

During National Police Week, the Westland Police Department unveiled its next generation of hybrid electric patrol cars. The City of Westland purchased 20 Ford Police Interceptors for 2023 using American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds. Each new vehicle features a 3.3-liter HEV engine with 318 combined horsepower. Ford describes the model as the, "first-ever pursuit-rated hybrid police SUV." Even with all of that power, the next generation engines are approximately 25% more fuel efficient than Westland's previous fleet of Ford Explorers. WLPD also opted for a new color scheme for the fleet, switching to Ford's Carbonized Gray. The patrol cars will be outfitted with all-new technology allowing for officers to have access to as much information as possible while on patrol or responding to incidents. As a police department, WLPD is committed to not only protecting the community, but also doing its part to reduce its carbon footprint. These cars will help the department patrol the streets more efficiently while also reducing emissions and promoting sustainability. "We are very proud to have one of the first police departments in the area to take the eco-friendly step of transitioning to hybrid patrol cars, and is a major achievement in our city wide commitment to responsibly moving to earth friendly practices", commented Mayor Michael P. Londeau.

CERTIFICATION: The City of Westland will undertake the projects described above with CDBG and HOME funds from the HUD. The City of Westland certifies to HUD that the City and Mayor Michael P. Londeau, in his capacity as Mayor, consent to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to environmental reviews and administrative action, and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. The legal effect of the certification is that upon its approval, the City of Westland may use the CDBG and HOME funds, and HUD will have satisfied its responsibilities under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969. 
